Reserve Rum of Grenada is distilled in 2003 at Westerhall Estates and then shipped to the UK and filled to used oak barrels for maturation in Bristol Spirits' cool damp cellars. Westerhall Estate began making rum in the 1700s. They have always enjoyed a strong local following, and the access to pure water and fresh cane juice made their products distinct from the beginning. This Reserve Rum of Grenada is column still which produces a light, elegant and juicy rum.

Nose: Sweet fruits.

Palate: Sweetness and length on the palate with well-integrated wood. You can enjoy it on the rocks or in a delicious drink.
