

EL RON PROHIBIDO



El Ron Prohibido is a Mexican rum with a great heritage. The name Prohibido, spanish word for forbidden, is given because this rum was prohibited back in 1796 by the spanish king, Felipe V De Borbon, because it was a threat to the local Spanish products. El Ron Prohibido is 12 years premium Solera rum whose special sweet and sour taste has been achieved by mixing different aged rums and subsequently aging them in old wine barrels.

Nose: Dried fruit and sweet walnut with touches of sugar and vanilla.

Palate: Sweet with bitter notes and an intense flavour of raisins, grape, plums, cherry, honey and dark chocolate and som touches of vanila, wood and walnut. It has a Long and silky finish, with a touch of caramel and slightly bitter.
