

## **BRISTOL SPIRITS, RESERVE RUM OF BELIZE**



Bristol Spirits is classic rum and single vintage. Every bottle is dated with a vintage year. This rum is from Travellers Liquor in Belize. The story of Travellers started in 1953 when Jaime Omario Perdomo Sr. opened a bar in Belize city called Travellers. Omario made his own rum, and it became very popular so he signed an agreement with Luis Alberto Espat, which was the beginning of Travellers Liquor.

## Tasting notes:

This Column Still Rum shows fruit, almonds and spicy wood on the nose, which is carried through on the palate with notes of vanilla and mild caramel. It has a good and pleasant finish with some length and style. After a while in the glass, you will feel an increasing sweetness.
