## S.B.S GUYANA 2003



S.B.S Guyana 2003 comes from a single cask, which yielded 264 bottles, produced at the Single Wooden Versailles Still, which today is placed at Diamond Distillery (owned by Demerara Distilleries) in Guyana after being moved from the Versailles Distillery. Versailles Distillery was originally on the West bank of the Demerara. Rumors say that this still is at least 150 years old, but it could be much older as there is no documentation from when it was built.

**Nose:** Old Marsala cask, ripe bananas, almonds, vanilla sugar, toasted bread, prunes and raisins.

**Palate:** First the alcohol strikes and leaves a dry mouth feel. Afterwards it opens with lots of oak, light caramel, bitter citrus like pomelo, star anise, liquorice and cinnamons.

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**Country:** Guyana

**Distillery:** Diamond Distillery

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**Alcohol:** 62,8% alc.

**Age:** 12 years

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
