S.B.S Panama 2001 comes from a single cask, which yielded 252 bottles. No distillery is stated at the label of this Panama rum, but that has been specially chosen for the S.B.S series, which is a selection of the finest spirits.

Even though Panama is primarily known for its canal, that connects the Pacific Ocean with the Atlantic Ocean, they have much more to offer, ex. some great rums, partially thanks to the country's wealth of sugarcane, which contributes to Panama's stockpile of rum.

Nose: Tropical citrus, orange marmalade, butterscotch, cinnamon, vanilla cream, chestnut, ripe apples, plumes, prunes and burned tires.

Palate: Light and dry young cask with lots of vanilla, heavy dark notes of cinnamon, bitter citrus pomelo peel, banana, raw cacao beans, hard toasted bread, brown sugar and crabapples.
