



Severin Rhum Blanc

Notes: Séverin Blanc is made by The Séverin Estate, known in Guadeloupe as "Domaine de Séverin". Séverin Estate was established at the beginning of the 19th century by Mr Séverin who bought the Bellevue Estate.

Guadeloupe is known for its specialisation in Agricole rum, which is the French term for cane juice rum, a style of rum originally distilled in the French Caribbean Islands from freshly sugar cane juice rather than molasses.

Séverin Blanc is a white rum matured for a minimum of 6 months in stainless steel vats.

Nose: Exotic fruit, brown sugar and caramel.

Palate: Fruity, oily and warm with a long finish

and a liquorice after taste.

Colour: Transparent

Age: Matured for a minimum of 6 months

Alcohol: 55% **Vol:** 0,7 L.
