

PISCO PURO DE UVA TORONTEL



Pisco is a more than 400 years old transparent and yellowish brandy, which is made in Peru and Chile. Pisco is a national drink, and the recipe is often passed on through families and distilleries along the Peruvian coast. The spirit is made in the wine regions of Peru and Chile, like this Pisco from Sarcay de Acpitia, which is made in Azpitia, 80 km from Lima. Sarcay de Azpitia get their inspiration from the land in Azpitia, which is a fertile valley where terroir allows the grapes to grow with a uniqueness that makes their Pisco one of a kind.

Tasting notes:

Sarcay de Azpitia Pisco Puro is made from a single grape and not a blend. This is the only 100% Spirit of Wine in the world, and it has delicate touches of flowers and fruits and is a perfect friend for a delightful "Pisco Sour".
