S.B.S Jamaica 2007 is from a single cask with only 241 bottles. The rum is a distillate from Monymusk and enjoyed a PX finish. Monymusk Plantation rum is distilled and blended by National Rums of Jamaica Limited. The name Monymusk comes from the sugar cane area of the same name, which already produced rum and sugar before abolishing slavery, and continues to supply the distillery with rich Jamaican molasses.
Nose: Complex aromas of exotic fruits, ripened bananas and spice mux with a hint of tobacco.
Palate: Very complex with notable PX influence. Fruity in the beginning, ending in typical Jamaican funkiness reminding of rubber and gasoline.
