

KINGSBARNS NEW MAKE SPIRIT



With the Lowlands being an under-represented region for Scotch malt whisky, the aim of producing this new make spirit is to present a light and fruity character of spirit in a Lowland style. It is bottled at 63.5%, the same strength at which the casks are filled. Scotch Whisky has to mature for at least 3 years and a day in oak casks and so the new make spirit will give curious whisky drinkers a unique chance to taste and sample the unmatured spirit.

Nose: Very light on the nose with orchard fruits leading the way. Peaches, apricots and pears are all

present along with some floral, citrus elements and light cereal notes adding complexity.

Palate: The taste follows the nose with nectarines coming to mind and a sweet finish on the palate.
