



## BRISTOL SPIRITS, CARONI TRINIDAD RUM

---



Once there were more than fifty distilleries in Trinidad and Tabago but by 1950 that number had fallen down to eight distilleries, and in 2002 Caroni distillery's fate were also sealed and they had to close. Bristol Spirits have shipped a number of casks of 'Old Cask' from Caroni back in 2008, which were already 10 years old and reduced to 40% vol. for bottling in 2004 but never bottled. They have used some of these for various blends and decided to use the last for this bottling. The strength had fallen below 40% so Bristol blended in some 1993 to raise the strenght and to give the blend some more body.

**Tasting notes:** A classic Caroni rum with a dry character and a complex nose with wood, fruit and spice. This shows on the palate with good length and style. You will feel notes of dried fruits like banana, blackcurrant, apples and toasted hazelnut, tobacco, coffee and fresh leather.
