S.B.S Guyana 1988 comes from a single cask, which yielded 180 bottles. This is pot still rum from the now closed Enmore Sugar Estate in Guyana. The still, which is used for this rum, doesn't exist anymore. Enmore Sugar Estate was founded nearly 200 years ago, and owned by Edward Henry Porter (initials: EHP), but it had to close in 1993 when the government in Guyana privatized the countries' sugar plantations and distilleries structuring them into one large distillery: Diamond Distillery, which is owned by Demerara Distilleries.

Nose: Soft, light toffee, milk chocolate, vanilla, muscovado sugar, matured plums and mild hints of blackberry. Palate: Dry leather, Irish coffee, banana peel, very dry sherry, lightly burned sugar and soft peach.
