S.B.S MAURITIUS 2012



S.B.S Mauritius comes from a single cask, which yielded 128 bottles. It is distilled by La Bourdonnaise on their continuous still. La Bourdonnaise Estate is placed in the north of the Island of Mauritius. The distillery was built in 2006, and it operates from June to December during the sugarcane harvest. La Bourdonnaise creates authentic rums based on the quality of their juice, the yeast strain used during the fermentation process and modern techniques. Mauritius is a relative newcomer to the global rum market. Until 2006, Mauritius produced only small amounts of rum from molasses. Then the government lifted a ban on distilling from sugar cane juice to produce Agricole rum.

This brought new players to the rum market in Mauritius.

Nose: Salt, olives, watermelon, pear, figs and burned bread.

Palate: Brown bananas, salted orange, bitter plum stone. Mild notes of bitter three and a bit vanilla in the end.

Country: Mauritius

Distillery: La Bourdonnaise

Alcohol: 46,60% alc.

Age: 6 years
