



EL SALVADOR 2011



The small country of Salvador, located between Honduras and Guatemala, enjoys a tropical climate and a volcanic soil conducive to sugar cane farming. Maja rums are made from molasses and distilled in a 4 column still. After distillation, the ABV of the rum is between 78% and 98%, which is then aged in American white oak barrels and reduced between 55% and 75% before bottling. The blends are mastered by Don Pancho Fernandez, a Cuban maestro ronero, renowned for his experience and expertise.

Tasting Notes

Open on the nose on smoke and burnt wood notes. A greedy palate with exotic fruit jam, orange marmelade and vanilla. A long and delicate finish.
