



ST. LUCIA 2012



St. Lucia Distillers was born in 1972 from fusion of two distilleries on the island. Its international recognition is due in large part to Laurie Barnard, director of the distillery for four decades. With its four stills, three pot stills and one column, in addition to their savoir-faire of aging and blending St. Lucia produces a fine collection of traditional rums including Chairman's Reserve and Admiral Rodney, two legendary signatures of the group.

Tasting Notes

Open one the nose with citrus aroma. Immediate impression of smoothness and sweet spices in mouth evolving to dried vanilla, orange marmelade notes. Long finish with subtle aromas of liquorice.
