

JAMAICA TRELAWNEY COUNTY 2009 - 2021



Bristol Spirits are long-established and eminent suppliers and promoters of fine rums from around the world. John is renowned and recognised as a highly-experienced taster and supporter of rums in their most natural state, specialising often in those rums matured and bottled in UK warehousing which have unique benefits. This Bistol release is a rum from the Trelwney Country of Jamaica, and was distilled in a pot still at a restricted distillery in 2009. The rum arrived in UK in 2014 and matured in a refill American oak barrel. The rum is bottled at 47,5% abv without chillfiltration.

Tasting Notes

Pale golden in colour, powerful nose full of fruit and high esters typical of production of pot still work from

Trelawney County. Palate has up-front power with fruit leading to a medium length finish typical of this style of production,

powerful Rum best enjoyed over ice.
