

TRINIDAD & TOBAGO 2009



On the small Caribbean Island of Trinidad & Tobago, one of the original birthplaces of rum, the culture of sugarcane dates back to the 18th century. Originally colonized by the Spanish and then the English, today the nation remains true to its British heritage by producing traditional rums distilled from column stills. The superb sugarcane "eau-de-vie" has made Trinidad & Tobago one of the most reputable distillers of fine rum. Trinidad & Tobago 2009 has matured in ex-Bourbon casks and is limited to 2.121 bottles.

Tasting Notes

Nose: A first nose of solvent aromas.

Palate: A sharp attack in the mouth with aromas of overripe fruits, tobacco and spices. A nice long finish with notes of smooth spices and burnt caramel.
